PROGRAMS

January 16th, 2014.

The class will discuss different types of beads and attaching beads to canvas and other ground fabrics. Students to bring a doddle canvas/cloth, several types of beads, beading needle and stranded thread (floss or silk). There will be a penguin handout to be bead stitch by student. There are 3 penguins on the handout, to practice what was learned in class. Beaded stitch on 14 count plastic canvas or 14 count perforated paper, this can be a self finishing project.

February 20th:

A Pat Mazu charted project - Uncle Sam's Hat, a top hat ornament stitched in red white, blue and gold. A fun patriotic piece for May to July. Signup sheet at January meeting. Materials list will be emailed after meeting to all who sign up.

March 20th: Charted small piece with 5 colors of floss, design by Margery L. Williams. Can be stitched as a Spring Egg, or as a square for a fob or pin cushion. Model at Jan and Feb meetings with sign up sheet. Happy New Year with lots of fun stitching.

A little more about the January 16 Class

This class is a practice on doodle material with beads. There will be several sheets of information on the do's & don'ts on beading and a sheet of diagrams. Discussion and practice.

So I suggest you bring the following items. I will also have a chart for 3 different penguins to stitch on 14 count perforated paper, plastic canvas or ground fabric of your choice. They can also be crossed stitched or needlepointed. These will be stitched at home.

6 x 6 - 18 canvas or Aida; or 14 count plastic or perforated paper; just one type not all; mounted on bars it will be easier to handle.

Needles - #10 long and short beading needles and #28 tapestry needle if you have one.

Thread - floss or splendor: and if you have it beading thread and nylon thread,

Beads that you have, do not go buy additional, for example:

Sundance #11, Sundance #14:

Mill Hill Seed bead, petite bead, bugle beads any size.

Assorted beads like Delica's, #8, triangle, marguerites, bicones, sequins.

Bead container like tacky bob or similar, if you have it.


A pair of magnets.
