Installation of Officers**

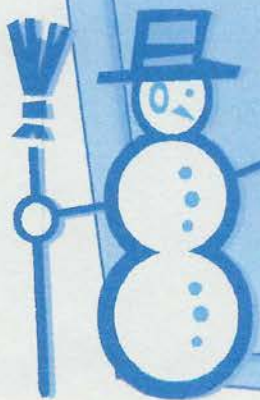
